

“Be Prepared” Registration Night Check List

Bring...

Youth Information

- Doctor's Name
- Doctor's Phone #
- Health Card#
- Allergy information
- Details of special care and/or medication.
- Date of last Tetanus shot
- Emergency Contact person Name & Phone# (This is not you or your spouse. This should be someone we could contact in the event we can't reach you. Someone who would likely know how to find you.)

Parent Information

- Home/work and cell phone #'s for parents
- Private insurance company and policy #

Payment

- We will accept cash or cheque.
- Multiple postdated cheques are acceptable.
- Do not write your cheque until you reach the treasurer.
- Make all cheques payable to 'Scouts Canada'.

- Volunteer Signup Sheet
(you received with your registration package)
 - You must sign up for at least 2 tasks

- Bring any questions you might have.

- Bring a friend that you think may be interested in joining.

Assistance

If the fees are a little much to handle all at once, we will accept partial payments by post-dated cheque.

We will not turn a youth away from any Scouting activity due to a lack of financial resources. Please contact your section leader or our Group Commissioner if such difficulties arise so arrangements can be made quietly, without the youth's knowledge.

When you arrive to register. . .

1. Pick up your 2011-2012 registration forms. If you are a returning member, these will be mostly complete but will need updates and corrections. You will also receive a 'Help Needed' form (if you forgot yours), and a camp sign up form.
2. This is where you can sit to complete the forms. There will be help here if needed. Grab a coffee or juice while you are at it.
3. Proceed to visit each section that you are registering youth for. The first section you visit will give you an invoice which you will need to present to each table as you go around..
4. Next, proceed to the Fall Camp table to sign up everyone that is planning to attend Fall Camp from your family – registered youth, adults & leaders. We will help you with the camp part of the invoice too.
5. This is a table where you can find uniforms (and parts of) that have already experienced some of the Scouting Life! (Scouting prices too!)
6. Here you can learn about your SAST Fund & our 2 largest fundraisers and how they can help you enjoy Scouting.
7. Last, visit the treasurer with your now completed invoice. You can pay by SAST, cash (correct change) or cheque. We can arrange for postdated cheques too.
