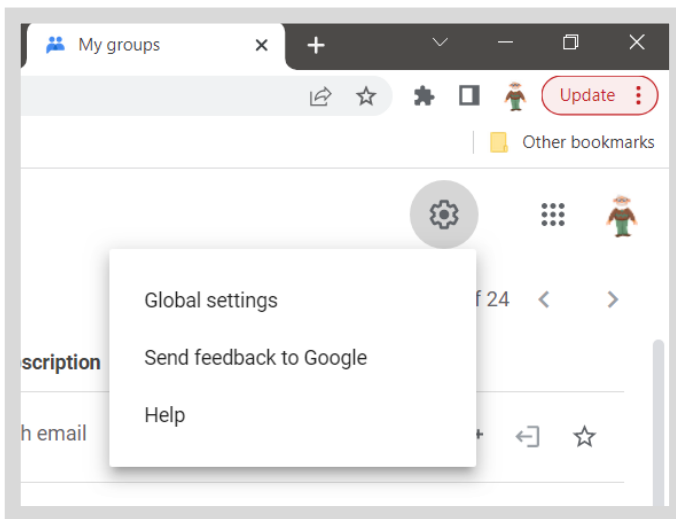
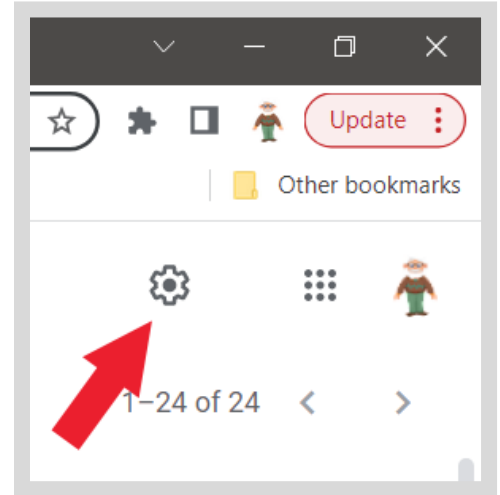


The 24th Kitchener Scouting Family uses Google Groups to support the Distribution List facility. Signing up using the 24th Kitchener's Email Distribution List Sign-Up facility puts you on a list of e-mail addresses to be included in a Google group. Being put in the group is contingent on each person's Google group "Global settings"

The upper right corner of the <https://groups.google.com/my-groups> page looks like this. Select the setting wheel.

A popup will appear. Select "Global settings"



The Global Settings pop up looks like this. The check mark beside "Add me to their groups" enables the ability for the manager of a group to add the user. The check mark beside "Invite me to their groups" enables the ability for the manager of a group to invite the user. If both these settings are unchecked, there is no way to get the "me" into a group.

If you really want to have these unchecked, but want to get Distribution List communications, then check the "Add" and send an e-mail to Commissioner@24th.ca and say you've allowed being added to a Google group until being in the 24th Kitchener group, and then you want to uncheck "Add".
